Order for the size in all classes will be small, medium and large.

For the team competitions will be determined by draw Friday.

The winner of each course in individual are rewarded right after the course is run.

During the competitions, one dog is running the course while the three others are waiting for their turn in the start area.

The 15 second start rule is applied. The competitor has 15 seconds to start the run after the judge has given permission. It will be displayed. After the 15 seconds, the time will start.

Bitches in heat will start on a blanket.

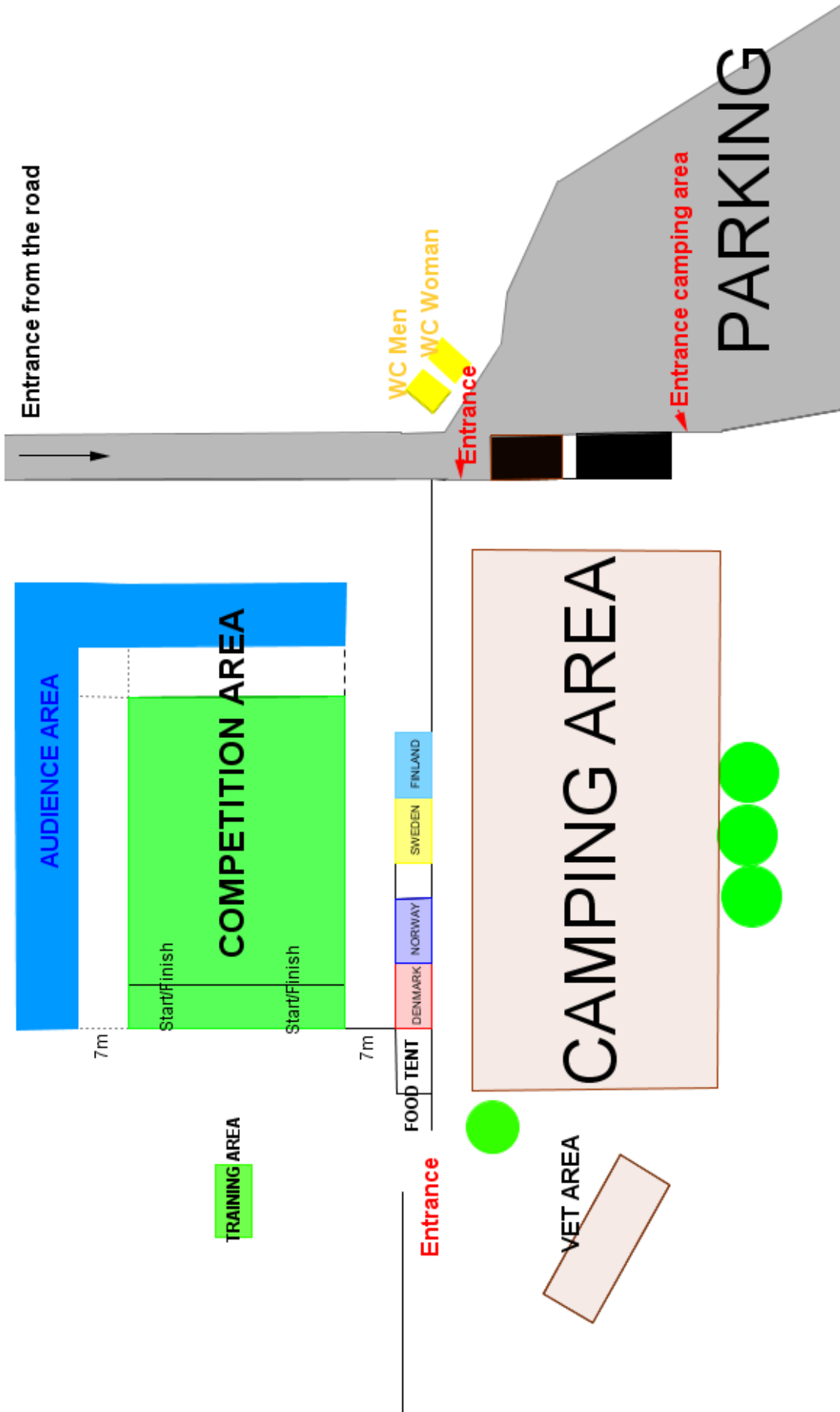
